- F.W.S. publishes and ships more than eighty thousand pieces of S.L.A.A. literature and recovery tools each year.
- F.W.S. assists new groups in getting started, a particularly critical role in areas where there are no groups.
- F.W.S. gives free information packets to potential newcomers as well as to service professionals from around the world.
- F.W.S. provides logistical support to the S.L.A.A. committees that develop new literature, provide prison outreach, oversee conventions, and take on many other essential tasks.
- F.W.S. provides worldwide meeting information to newcomers and members who move or travel and maintains a comprehensive database of approximately 1000 worldwide groups, Intergroups, group contacts, meeting times and dates on the official S.L.A.A.-F.W.S. website.
- F.W.S. sponsors the Annual Business Meeting (which is coming to San Diego from July 24-27, 2012!)
